Notice to the IAs & Associates

5<sup>th</sup> July 2023

On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 2023, the steering committee for the TIGG project resolved the following,

- the implementation locations for the TIGG project shall be specific to the provinces/states in every country instead of the exact cities within provinces/states;
- the implementation agencies shall have the autonomy of the exact locations for choosing the beneficiaries within the given provinces/states they are authorized to;
- the number of beneficiaries has been reallocated for every country wise;
- the implementation agencies shall have the autonomy to conduct the program anywhere within the country;
- the implementation agencies shall choose the mode of delivery of the program within the stipulated time
- resolved further that the no. of beneficiaries provided per country per province/state basis is a guideline and is subject to change at the sole discretion of the steering committee
